Five-Year General Services Agreement with the County of Los Angeles for Miscellaneous County Services on an As-Needed Basis (Finance Director Moe).

APPROVE; ADOPT RESOLUTION

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends that the City Council adopt Resolution No. 17-0034 approving the County of Los Angeles General Services Agreement for a five year period beginning July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2022.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS:

There are no fiscal implications associated with the recommended action. Any expenditures made pursuant to this agreement will be considered as part of the biennial budget process.

BACKGROUND:

From time to time, the City utilizes the County of Los Angeles to perform various services. These include, but are not limited to, direct assessment collection through the consolidated property tax bill, traffic signal maintenance, police support services and election services. The General Services Agreement provides the framework permitting the City to use the County for the various services as needed. Each of the services has an associated cost subject to the County's rate in effect at the time

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the service is performed.

DISCUSSION:

The General Services Agreement was originally adopted by the City Council in 1961 and has been renewed periodically since then. The current five-year agreement was last renewed in 2012 and will expire June 30, 2017. Staff recommends renewing the General Services Agreement for a five-year period (through June 30, 2022) to ensure continued availability of County services when needed.

PUBLIC OUTREACH/INTEREST:

After analysis, staff determined that public outreach was not required for this issue.

ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW:

Not required for this agreement.

LEGAL REVIEW

The City Attorney has reviewed the agreement and has approved it as to form.
