### RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends that City Council adopt Ordinance No. 18-0013 amending the Manhattan Beach Municipal Code to authorize the City Council to conditionally issue special permits for the service of alcohol on the beach under very limited circumstances.

### FISCAL IMPLICATIONS:

There are no fiscal implications associated with the recommended action.

### BACKGROUND:

On April 3, 2018, the City Council introduced Ordinance No. 18-0013 authorizing the City Council to conditionally approve special permits for the service of alcohol on the beach under very limited circumstances on a case-by-case basis. Prior to the first reading, the City Council added a sunset

clause, which automatically repeals the ordinance, without further action by the City Council, on August 31, 2018.
