**ADOPT ORDINANCE NO. 19-0012**

**RECOMMENDATION:**  
Staff recommends that the City Council adopt Ordinance No. 19-0012 amending the Manhattan Beach Municipal Code to regulate wireless facilities in the City's rights-of-way.

**FISCAL IMPLICATIONS:**  
Fiscally neutral. The Federal Communications Commission (FCC) has imposed limits on the amounts cities may charge wireless telecommunications providers.

**BACKGROUND:**  
On April 16, 2019 the City Council introduced Ordinance No. 19-0012 and adopted Resolution No. 19-0044 setting forth design standards for wireless facilities.

**DISCUSSION:**

Staff recommends that the Council waive further reading and adopt Ordinance No. 19-0012.

**ENVIRONMENTAL ANALYSIS:**
