RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends that the City Council:

- C. Consider adopting the attached Resolution No. 20-0050 adopting the annual proposed rate

increases from July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2025.

BACKGROUND:

On May 5, 2020, City Council continued the public hearing to May 12, 2020 to provide additional time for the public to provide input on the proposed rate increases.
