WAIVE FURTHER READING; ADOPT ORDINANCE 13-0020

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends that City Council waive further reading, adopt Ordinance No. 13-0020 amending the Manhattan Beach Municipal Code regarding banners and decorations in the public right-of-way and adopt the attached policy.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS:

There is no fiscal impact on the City's General Fund associated with the proposed ordinance and policy. All costs for the hanging of banners for non-City sponsored events are fully paid for by the banner permittees.

BACKGROUND:
